

Re-Entry Plan for Faith United Methodist Church: August 2020

- **In the parking lot**, please practice social distancing/wearing masks when greeting one another.
- There will be **one entry point**. All persons are required to use the **double glass doors** (south side, where the church bus is parked) which will be **open at 8:45am**. After worship, please exit the sanctuary using the side aisles. All doors will be available to exit. Those who are able, please exit using the front or kitchen door.
- **Masks/facial coverings will be required** upon entering the building until you are seated in the sanctuary before worship and then as you leave your seat after worship. This is the minimal requirement. Optimally, we would like everyone to keep their face-covering in place throughout the service. However, we recognize there may be some persons who are unable to do so.
- You will be required to use **hand sanitizer upon entering the building and again prior to entering the sanctuary**. Hand sanitizing stations will be available. You will also be asked to use hand sanitizer upon leaving the building.
- **For elevator use, gloves are required** for operation. They will be available on a stand at the elevator door outside and inside the church. Waste baskets will be near the elevator doors for disposal.
- There will be **no Greeters at the sanctuary doors**. We recognize the desire for fellowship and ask that you please do so while maintaining social distancing. Please do not congregate prior to being seated.

- Use the **designated pews and sit socially distanced** (minimum of six feet). Households may sit together. Ushers will be available to assist.
- **No bulletins** will be provided on Sunday morning. The large screen will have all liturgy, announcements, and prayer concerns. Bulletins will continue to be emailed on Friday. You are welcome to print the materials at home and bring them with you on Sunday.
- Bibles and hymnals have been removed from the pews.
- There will be **no choir nor congregational singing** because forced air needed for singing projects droplets much further. Our musicians will play approximately ten minutes prior to the beginning of worship and at the conclusion. We are planning to use videos for the hymns. Everyone is invited to hum along.
- Regarding **the offering, baskets will be placed to receive your gifts**. You may also continue to mail or bring your offerings to the church.
- Restrooms on the sanctuary level will be open for use. Sanitizing wipes will be available, and we ask that you clean all touch areas after use to prepare the restroom for the next person.
- All worshipers are asked to **remain on the sanctuary level** while in the building.
- Someone will be taking attendance as we must be able to document who is in the building.
